INTRODUCTION

The D91 Education Foundation is pleased to present the "Heart of D91 Go On Award" to help D91 graduates and former D91 graduates pursue their educational goals after high school. The award can be used to pay for training, career certifications, apprenticeships, community college or technical school courses or college or university classes. Awards will be awarded to D91 graduating seniors and former D91 graduates currently pursuing some kind of post high school education.

ELIGIBILITY

To qualify for the awards, students must be:

- 1) On track to graduate from one of D91's four high schools OR a former graduate currently pursuing some kind of post high school education
- 2) Have a GPA of at least a 2.5

APPLICATION

To apply, students must submit the following:

- a) A completed application form
- b) A resume
- c) Prep for a short 5-question in-person interview. (*Interviews are tentatively scheduled for late April/early May. We will contact applicants to schedule interviews*)

SELECTION

Applicants will be evaluated based on the information provided and the in-person interview. An emphasis will be placed on students who may have had a slow start in high school, but are now focused on finishing strong and pursuing some type of education after high school.

DUE DATE

Applications are available from all D91's high school counseling offices, from D91's college and career advisors, from D91's District Office at 690 John Adams Parkway and from the D91 Ed Foundation website. Applications are due **April 21, 2023**. They may be turned in to a high school guidance counselor or counseling office no later than the close of school or to the D91's District Office no later than 4:30 pm on **April 21, 2023**. They can also be emailed to edfoundation@sd91.org no later than 4:30pm on **April 21, 2023**. Please include "scholarship" in the subject line.

***Please Note:** Awards will be paid directly to the training program, college or university. Award recipients must use the award within four (4) years. If the monies are not used within four (4) years of the award date, the funds will be forfeited and returned to the D91 Ed Foundation.
