6 Teach responsibility by having your child complete chores.



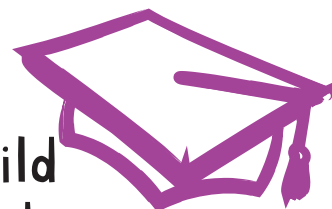
7 Talk about the difference between spending money on wants vs. needs
